ROYAL PATENT.

KAMEHAMEHA IV., By the grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands, by this His Royal Patent, makes known unto all men, that he has, for himself and his successors in office, this day granted and given, absolutely, in Fee Simple, unto *Wm. J. Neuham & Tho. E. Cook* his faithful and royally disposed subject, for the consideration of *1197.00*

Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situated at *Kaupo & Kahikinui* paid into the
in the Island of *Maui* and described as follows:

Portions of "Manuwaimii" & "Waispai"

Commencing at S.E. corner of land at stake, on small Bluff in Puhimakani, on Western edge of Pahiki Gulch and running S. by W 153.50 chains crossing Waispai Gulch at "pohakulua" and intersecting a wiliwili tree in Manuwaimii to a stake in Puakau-wia on Eastern edge of Manuwaimii Gulch thence $N 24 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W$ 155.60 chains along the edge of Manuwaimii Gulch to large koa tree Mokuhalii thence $N 54^{\circ} E$ 53.60 chains through edge of woods crossing Waispai Gulch to stake on Eastern edge of same in "Lahokiki" thence $N 60^{\circ} E$ 65.50 chains through edge of woods, crossing Waitaulau & Aloimawawae Gulches to small koa tree in Puhala on Western edge of Pahiki Gulch thence $S 44^{\circ} E$ 50.70 chains following Western edge of Pahiki Gulch to stake in Puhala on most Eastern projection of land into Pahiki Gulch thence $S 35^{\circ} E$ 130 chains to stake in "Puhii" makai at place of commencement.
