~~KAMEHAMEHA IV~~, By the grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands, by this His Royal Patent, makes known unto all men, that he has, for himself and his successors in office, this day granted and given, absolutely, in Fee Simple, unto Rebecca Wilkinson his faithful and loyally disposed subject, for the consideration of

One hundred and six (\$ 106⁰⁰) — dollars paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situated at Mamau Laupā in the Island of Hawaii and described as follows:

Beginning at stake on edge of gulch at N E edge of base AB on plan, and running by the magnetic meridian.

Containing *seventy, sixty five one hundredths* 70.65 Acres, more or less:
excepting and reserving to the Hawaiian Government, all mineral or metallic Mines of every description.

To have and to hold the above granted Land in Fee Simple, unto the said
Rebecca Wilkinson, Heirs and Assigns forever, subject to the
taxes to be from time to time imposed by the Legislative Council equally, upon all landed Property held in Fee Simple.

In Witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of
the Hawaiian Islands to be affixed, at Honolulu, this *third*
day of *January* 1879
