
Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situated at

in the Island of Mauu

and described as follows:

Beginning at a pile of stones on maha boundary from which the spine of Kijialulo Church bears N. 73° 24' E. and running by the magnetic meridian N. 21° 10' W 553.5 ft. Mauka along award N. 63° 16' E 254.0. " " grant S. 38° 59' E 514.0. maha " " S. 56° 35' W 440.5. to central point and containing 11.07 acres

* This is the open field a pasture above and below the road and has a slope of 13° towards the South East.





Containing 407 Acres, more or less:
excepting and reserving to the Hawaiian Government, all mineral or metallic Mines of every description.

To have and to hold the above granted Land in Fee Simple, unto the said
Mauu Kahuna'auole, Heirs and Assigns forever, subject to the
taxes to be from time to time imposed by the Legislative Council equally, upon all landed Property held in Fee Simple.

In Witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of
the Hawaiian Islands to be affixed, at Honolulu, this 10
day of January 1879
