By this His Royal Patent, makes known to all men, that he hath for himself, his heirs and successors, this day granted and given unto

Kamakuohai

for the consideration of Fifty seven ⁵³/₁₀₀ Dollars paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situate at

Keolu

in the Island of

Mauai

and described as follows:
