

## ROYAL PATENT.

GRANT.

Liliuokalani, \* By the Grace of God, Queen of the Hawaiian Islands:

By this Her Royal Patent makes known to all men, that She hath  
for herself, her heirs and successors, this day granted and given unto

William Mutch

for the consideration of an agreement from W. Mutch to the Hawaiian Government  
dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June 1892 and recorded in the Registrar Office Libr. 137 Page 62  
paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situate at

Kaupo in the Island of

Maui — and described as follows:

Beginning at N.W. angle of Grant 3457 Lot 1, at a cross  
on rock at 'Kauhakamoa' on boundary of the land of  
'mu' whence the boundary runs by true bearings  
N. 00° 46' 24. 8887 feet along land of 'mu' to a large rock marked  
with cross near Lehua trees at 'Keolepelepe'  
N. 7° 7' 24. 1808 feet along 'mu' to large rock marked cross at  
Kaupo trail at 'Dohakuhiaina'.  
N. 00° 46' 24. 6315 feet along 'mu' to pile of stones 12 feet South-east  
of a cross cut on rock, on spur South-west of  
'Dohakuhiaina' near a large crater called  
'Kaiuanui'

N. 33° 18' E. 2510 feet to 'Dohakuhiaina' on rim of crater  
at junction of Kailialinui, Hakuhi and Keanae.

S. 56° 53' E. 1150 feet to Govt Survey Station 'Kaiuanui'.


Thence following summit of dividing ridge between Haleakala  
crater and Kipahulu valley to point bearing S. 12° 30' E. true  
distance 4603 feet.

Thence following said dividing ridge, and rim of crater to  
'Pakili' which point bears S. 5° 09' E. (true) distant 2794 feet.

Thence along rim of crater, and crest of wall of Kaupo Gap,  
to point bearing S. 4° 00' E. true dist 11062 feet called "Kaumikaoehui".

Thence S. 56° 20' E. 3200 feet along Grant 3457 Lot 1 to Kauhakamoa  
the initial point.

— Area 1200 Acres a little more or less —



Containing 1200 Acres  
more or less; excepting and reserving to the Hawaiian Government all  
mineral or metallic mines of every description.

To Have and to Hold the above granted Land in Fee Simple, unto the  
said William Murray — his — Heirs and Assigns forever.

Witness Ourselves at Honolulu, this 26  
day of June 1842 in the Second  
year of Our Reign.
