

## ROYAL PATENT.

### GRANT.

**Lilinokalani**, By the Grace of God, Queen of the Hawaiian Islands:

By this Her Royal Patent makes known to all men, that She hath for herself, her heirs and successors, this day granted and given unto

William Mutch

for the consideration of an agreement from Wm Mutch to the Hawaiian Government dated the 21st day of June 1892 and recorded in the Registrar office Liber 117 Page 62 part into the Wesley Crocker, all that piece of Land situate at

Kaupo in the Island of

Maui and described as follows:

Beginning at N. W. angle of Grant 3457 Lot 1, at a cross on rock at 'Kauhakamoa' on boundary of the land of 'Nuu' thence the boundary runs by true bearings:

N. 00° 46' 21". 5557 feet along land of 'Nuu', to a large rock, marked with cross near Lehua trees at 'Keolepelepe'.

N. 7° 7' 21". 1808 feet along 'Nuu' to large rock marked cross at Kaupo trail at 'Pohakuloa'.

N. 00° 44' 21". 6315 feet along 'Nuu' to pile of stones 12 feet South-east of a cross set on rock, on spur South-west of 'Pohaku ohina' near a large crater called 'Kaluamui'.

N. 33° 18' E. 2510 feet to 'Pohaku ohina' on rim of crater at junction of 'Kalialinui', 'Lakui' and 'Keanae'.

S. 56° 53' E. 440 feet to Govt Survey Station 'Kaluamui'.

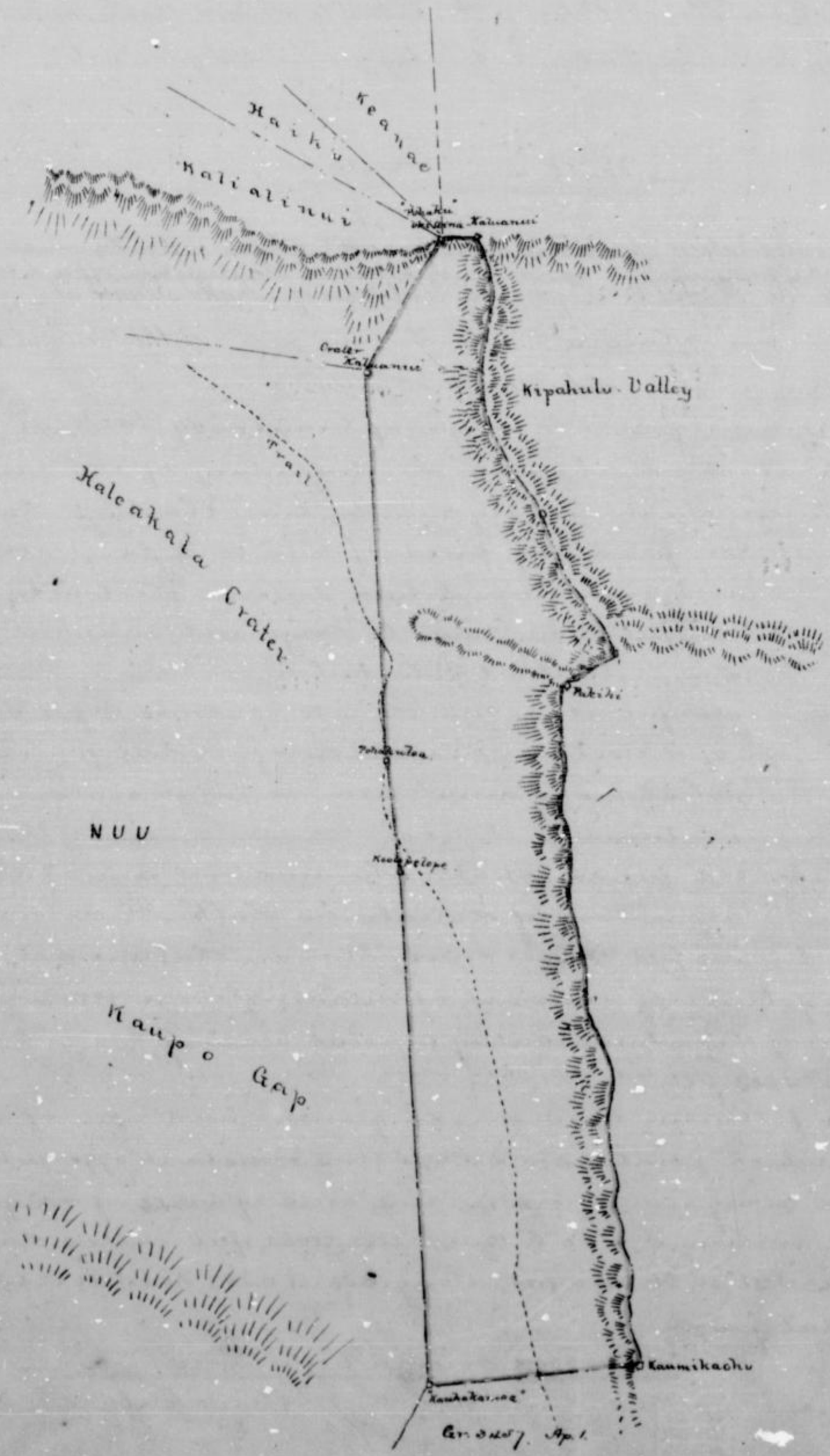
Thence following summit of dividing ridge between 'Kaleakala' crater and 'Kipahulu' valley to point bearing S. 12° 30' E. true distance 4653 feet.

Thence following said dividing ridge, and rim of crater to 'Pakih'i' which point bears S. 5° 39' E. (true) distant 2790 feet.

Thence along rim of crater, and crest of wall of 'Kaupo Gap', to point bearing S. 4° 00' E. true dist. 11062 feet called 'Kaumikashii'.

Thence S. 56° 20' N. 3400 feet along Grant 3457 Lot 1 to 'Kauhakamoa' the Initial point.

Area 1209 Acres a little more or less.

 more or less; excepting and reserving to the Hawaiian Government all  
 mineral or metallic mines of every description.

To Have and to Hold the above granted Land in Fee Simple, unto the  
 said William Matak — his — Heirs and Assigns forever.
