An application to decide and certify the
 Boundaries of the Land of... New, Kaupo - District
 of... Hana... Island of... Maui... having been
 filed with me on the... 29th... day of June... 1896,
 by Cecil Brown for Queen Dowager Kapiolani and
 James Campbell, in accordance with the provisions
 of an Act to facilitate the settlement of Boundaries;
 now, therefore, having duly received and heard all the
 testimony offered in reference to the said boundaries
~~and having gone on the said land at the request of~~

and having endeavored otherwise to obtain all in-
 formation possible to enable me to arrive at a just
 decision, which will more fully appear by reference
 to the records of this matter by me kept in Book
 No. 1, page... 61..., and it appearing to my satis-
 faction that the true, lawful and equitable boundaries
 are as follows, viz:

Commencing at a stone marked with a cross at
 the sea beach, from which stone the Government Survey
 Station Palakia bears $N. 50^{\circ} 14' E.$ true;

Station N. bears $S. 88^{\circ} 3' 21" W.$ true, and running:-
 1: $N. 31^{\circ} 21' E.$ true 249.5 feet along Nakula to a stone
 marked thus - on lower edge of Government Road
 at a place called Huskine.

2: $N. 7^{\circ} 7' 21" W.$ true 9804 ft. along Nakula to a cross on
 a stone 150 ft. East of two kukui trees at a place
 called Alanui Chua;

3: $N. 12^{\circ} 32' W.$ true 17251 ft. along Nakula to a stone
 marked thus - under a pile of stones on the
 south rim of Haleakala Crater at a place called
 Kumuihiki.

- 4: N. $18^{\circ} 21'$ E. true 7600 ft. along Paloi to a pile of stones in the bottom of the crater at a place called Teahuakoho 325 ft. North of a pit called Kaluarumi;
- 5: N. $72^{\circ} 5'$ E. true 6110 ft. along Paloi to a pile of stones on a spur south of Hanakauahi; Thence
- 6: S. $85^{\circ} 24'$ E. true 11358 ft. along Paloi passing near a cave and spring called Lue to a pile of stones 12 ft. South East of a cross cut on a stone on a spur South West of Pohakukisina, near a large crater called Kaluani; Thence
- 7: S. $0^{\circ} 44'$ E. true 6313 ft. along Lole, Grant 3602 to W. Mutch, passing near Waipani to a large rock (at the Kaupo trail) marked with a cross, and called Pohakulou.
- 8: S. $7^{\circ} 7'$ E. true 1808 ft. along Lole, Gr. 3602 to W. Mutch, to a large rock marked with a cross near some Lehua trees and called Keolepelepe;
- 9: S. $0^{\circ} 46'$ E. true 8387 feet along Kaho and Kow, Grant 3602 to W. Mutch, to a cross on a stone at a place called Kaunakimoa.
- 10: S. $27^{\circ} 44'$ W. true 17923 feet along Kow and Puumanono, Gr. 3457 to A. V. Marcell Grant 2816 to A. W. Cro, Grant 3460 to W. Mutch, to a large pile of stones on a rocky knoll;
- 11: S. $47^{\circ} 46'$ W. true 715 feet along Puumanono, Grant 3444 to A. Sylvia, to the North West corner of Grant 1985 to Mahi;
- 12: S. $41^{\circ} 52'$ W. true 215 feet along Grant 1985.
- 13: S. $34^{\circ} 56'$ W. " 216.5 " " " 1985.
- 14: S. $12^{\circ} 46'$ W. " 442. " " " 1985.
- 15: S. $2^{\circ} 51'$ E. " 268. " " " 1985.
- 16: S. $19^{\circ} 15'$ E. " 350. " " Puumanono, Gr. 3444 to A. Sylvia, to sharp stone marked with a cross;
- 17: S. $3^{\circ} 3'$ W. true 722 ft. along Puumanono, Gr. 3444 to A. Sylvia to a stone marked thus \rightarrow on the upper side of the Government Road;
- 18: S. $19^{\circ} 28'$ W. true 170 feet along Puumanono, Gr. 3444;
- 19: N. $44^{\circ} 3'$ W. true 244 feet along Puumanono, Grant 3444 to a cross on a stone at edge of bluff at a place called Nunkalawa;

20: S. $24^{\circ}45'$ W. true 565 ft. along Puumaneone to the North corner of Gv. 2468. Ap. I, to Kekahunaole at lower edge of old road;

21: S. $17^{\circ}11'$ W. true 1125 ft. along Gv. 2468 to a stone marked thus \rightarrow at a place called Kalokoiki, from which stone the Government Survey Station Puumaneone bears N. $49^{\circ}35'$ E. true, Kalaeokailio S. $81^{\circ}12'$ E. true and Palaka N. $14^{\circ}56'$ W. true 5285 feet;

22: S. $4^{\circ}48'$ E. true 300 ft. along Gv. 2468 to sea at an old canoe harbor;

Thence along sea shore to initial point. The bearing from last point at canoe harbor to initial point being N. $66^{\circ}52'$ W. true 5650 feet.

Area 12,140 Acres.
