ROYAL PATENT.

KAMEHAMEHA III., By the grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands, by this His Royal Patent, makes known unto all men, that he has for himself and his successors in office, this day granted and given, absolutely, in Fee Simple unto *Abner Wilcox*, his faithful and loyally disposed subject for the consideration of *Five Hundred & one, $\frac{2}{100}$ Dollars*

, paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that certain piece of Land, situated at *Lepenti*, *Koolan*, in the Island of *Kauai*, and described as follows:

Commencing at the Seabeach at a large rock called Pakala, which stands on the North West corner of this land, and upon the boundary between Lepenti & Waipake, running from thence along the Sea beach S. 60° E. 44.50 chs to a ledge of rocks which forms the boundary between Lepenti and Kaakaaniu; from thence along said boundary, crossing the Hanalei & Koloa road S. 36° W. 84 chs to the edge of the Pali bounding the valley of Molooa on the West. from thence along the edge of said pali S. 45° W. 6.50 chs to a stake. from thence down the side of said pali S. 11° E. 14 chs. to the Molooa river, near lone Kukui tree. from thence up said river S. 77° W. 10 chs. to a Kukui. from thence S. 12° W. 39 chs. up said river. from thence N. 77° W. 12 chs. up the side of the pali to an ohia tree on its edge. from thence N. 52½° W. 28.50 chs. to a stake. from thence N. 21° E. 25 chs. to a stake near a mountain road which forms the boundary between Lepenti & Waipake. from thence N. 37° E. 33 chs. to a stake near said road. from thence N. 19° E. 43 chs to a stake. from thence N. 82½° E. 28.50 chs. to a stake. from thence N. 22° E. to point of Commencement.
