~~KAMEHAMEHA IV~~, By the grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands, by this His Royal Patent, makes known unto all men, that he has, for himself and his successors in office, this day granted and given, absolutely, in Fee Simple, unto *Charles G. Bishop* or his faithful and loyally disposed subject, for the consideration of *Five Thousand* Dollars (*\$5,000.±*) paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situated at *Kaluakiki*, in the Island of *Molokai* and described as follows:

Commencing at Momiuni at the intersection
with Palawan marked by a pile of stones and running as follows—

To have and to hold the above granted Land in Fee Simple, unto the said Chart. R.
Bishop His Heirs and Assigns forever, subject to the
taxes to be from time to time imposed by the Legislative Council equally, upon all landed Property held in Fee Simple.

the Hawaiian Islands to be affixed, at Honolulu, this Twenty sixth
day of January 1876
