By this His Royal Patent, makes known to all men, that he hath for himself, his heirs and successors, this day granted and given unto

P. Kama'i

for the consideration of *Two Hundred & sixty Dollars* paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situate at *Kiikāupēa*

*Kaupo
Maui*

in the Island of

and described as follows :

Beginning at a point on *Hana Road* from which N.E. of Grant N^o 2467 to *Pali* bears N 88° 20' E & dist. 67 ft.

Thence N 18° 50'	N 575 ft	to rock S.E. of Kukui Grant 1917
" N 15° 40'	W 949 "	" Pale of stones along "
" S 80° 00'	E 827 "	" Intersection with stone wall
" S 25° 15'	E 1038 "	" Hana Road along Grant 2867
