ROYAL PATENT

Upon Confirmation of the Land Commission.

Whereas, The Board of Commissioners to quiet Land Titles have by their decision awarded unto

— H. Kalama — Land Commission Award # 4152 —

an estate of FREEHOLD less than Allodial, in and to the Land hereafter described, and whereas

proper application having been made to the Minister of the Interior by F. M. Hatch attorney for Nannie A. Rice the present owner of the Thupuaa of Kanoehe in the district of Koolanipoko Island of Oahu for a Royal Patent of the herein described land, a Certificate of Boundaries defining the same having been duly filed. And whereas the Government Commutation thereon was relinquished by resolution of the Privy Council adopted August 29th 1850

Therefore, Liliuokalani, By the Grace of God, Queen of the Hawaiian Islands, by this ROYAL PATENT, makes known to all men, that she has for herself, and her successors in office, this day granted and given absolutely, in Fee Simple, unto

all that certain piece of land situate at — Koolanipoko —
in the Island of Oahu — and described as follows:

- Beginning at a point on the bridge over small stream situated on the road between Honolulu and Kanoehe, and on the boundary line of Kaulekoha.
1. Thence S. 41° 50' N. true 8,140 feet to the peak Lanihuli.
 2. Along ridge of Pali between Kanoehe and Nuuanu, following the sinuosities thereof to a point on said ridge, being N. E. corner of Kaliki, bearing N. 51° 25' W. true 770 feet.
 3. Thence along ridge of Pali between Kanoehe and Kaliki, following its sinuosities to a point, being southerly corner of Kuou, bearing N. 29° 10' W. true 4295 feet.
 4. Thence along ridge of Pali, following its sinuosities, to a point, being southerly corner of the Crown Land Keaakala, bearing N. 22° 0' W. true 6370 feet.
 5. Thence N. 9° 45' E. true 3,170 feet along Keaakala.
 6. " N. 56° 05' E. " 5440 " Keaakala to northeasterly corner of same.
 7. " N. 56° 05' E. " 2220 " Kanohuluivi to a stone near west side of Government Road.
 8. Thence N. 50° 0' W. true 76 feet along Kanohuluivi.
 9. " N. 44° 50' E. " 2215 " "
 10. " N. 55° 10' E. " 1420 " Liliupuna to the Hawaiian Govt Survey Trig Station on Pine Pah.
 11. Thence N. 7° 20' E. true 1340 feet along Kalokohana hou.
 12. " N. 5° 25' W. " 415 " "
 13. " N. 60° 0' E. " 625 " "

14. Thence $N. 47^{\circ} 40' E$ true 8400 feet across the Bay of Kameho to the southwesterly corner of the land called Mookapu, situated at the northwesterly end of the Peninsula of Mookapu.
15. Thence $N. 65^{\circ} 15' E$ true 7410 feet along Mookapu
16. " $N. 16^{\circ} 20' W$ " 1500 " " to the seashore at high water mark
17. " along the seashore at high water mark to a point below the crater of Mookapu, bearing $N. 82^{\circ} 20' E$ true 8720 feet.
18. Thence along seashore at high water mark to a point near the crater of Mookapu, bearing $S. 75^{\circ} 50' E$ true 2245 feet.
19. Thence along seashore at high water mark to a point near the crater of Mookapu, bearing $S. 11^{\circ} 10' E$ true 1255 feet.
20. Thence along seashore at high water mark to a point in Ulupeau, bearing
21. $S. 36^{\circ} 0' W$ true 4175 feet.
21. Thence along seashore at high water mark to a point in Kahuapuhi waho bearing $S. 34^{\circ} 0' W$ true 4035 feet.
22. Thence along seashore at high water mark to a point in Aikapuli bearing $S. 9^{\circ} 40' W$ true 4775 feet.
23. Thence along seashore at high water mark to a point in Aikahi 700 feet north east of Tipalena's house, being ^{the easterly} northwesterly corner of Kailua, bearing $N. 84^{\circ} 25' W$ true 1320 feet.
24. Thence $S. 57^{\circ} 0' W$ true 3680 feet along Aikahi and Onoawa.
25. " $S. 72^{\circ} 30' W$ " 2060 " " to a point of ridge
26. " along the ridge, following its sinuosities to the northeast corner of Mahimui, L. C. A. 6460 bearing $S. 47^{\circ} 50' W$ 3620 feet.
27. Thence along the ridge following its sinuosities, to the southwesterly corner of Mahimui, bearing $S. 59^{\circ} 30' W$ true 4210 feet.
28. Thence along ridge following its sinuosities, along the southeasterly boundary of Keana to the southerly corner thereof bearing $S. 62^{\circ} 20' W$ true 1090 feet.
29. Thence along ridge, following the southeasterly boundary of the lands Kahuapuhi, Kahui and Hopemui, to the Flavin boat Survey Trig Station No 2 bearing $S. 2^{\circ} 0' E$ true 1980 feet.
30. Thence along ridge, following the easterly boundary of Kewaeuwa, Kalokoai &c. through all the sinuosities of said ridge to the northeasterly corner of Waikalua Waho, Crown Land, bearing $S. 26^{\circ} 25' W$ true 2700 feet.
31. Thence along said ridge, following its sinuosities along the easterly boundary of Waikalua Waho, to a point bearing $S. 12^{\circ} 20' W$ true 1400 feet.
32. Thence $S. 69^{\circ} 0' W$ true 620 feet along Waikalua Waho
33. " $N. 57^{\circ} 25' W$ " 1600 " " "
34. " $S. 29^{\circ} 10' W$ " 1000 " " Waikalua Loko to the bridge over stream on Government road being the point of beginning
